
SEWERS

The approval of the board of directors is required for all renovations. This includes any electrical update or construction, this is a requirement from our insurer.

Please be vigilant - close your unit's water valve when leaving for vacation, properly heat and dehumidify your basement and garage as mentioned in our bylaws and more than anything, please keep a close eye on your unit during severe weather.
